Students presenting an oral presentation or performance at the conference and following the instructions below are eligible for Outstanding Abstract Awards. Outstanding Abstract submissions may not be based on poster presentations.

Presentation of these awards will be made at the closing ceremonies of the conference.

TO APPLY FOR THE OUTSTANDING ABSTRACT AWARD:

- 1. Complete the appropriate Application and Registration form for the HTCC Student Research Conference (see the <u>Conference</u> page).
- 2. Prepare a 400-word awards abstract of your oral presentation or performance. See the <u>Conference</u> page for instructions and hints on preparing an abstract.
- 3. Send the abstract by e-mail attachment in either MS Word (or RTF [Rich Text Format] if you do not use MS Word) to Prof. John Oakes (john.oakes@gcccd.edu), HTCC Scholarship Committee Chair.
- 4. Ensure that your abstract be received in readable condition by the deadline indicated on the Scholarships page. Abstracts received after that date, or in an unreadable format, may not be considered.
- 5. Attend the conference and deliver the oral presentation or performance on which the submitted 400-word awards abstract is based.
